





DESIGN: RECYCLE, RESPONSIBLE

The 29-room Wanderlust hotel is recycled from a 1920s school. This experimental budget hotel designed by four local design powerhouses (Asylum, Phunk Studio, DP Architects and Ffurious) brings cool to the backpacking masses. It's not just a





minimalist interior inside a colonial facade, nor merely preserving heritage. The Wanderlust represents the gentrification of the once-louche red-light district into a culture hub.
